Intercomprehension is the practice of speaking or writing in one's mother tongue with a speaker of another language. The latter, without responding in the other's language, understands and responds in his other own language. This is not only a communicative and didactic approach, but also an ethical one, since it puts all the languages in the same family on an equal footing, while creating a genuine spirit of openness and linguistic parity and expression. From a European perspective, the possibility of understanding a large number of speakers without the need for translation and the opportunity to interact in one's own mother tongue **encourages community spirit and interculturality.**
