WHAT IS VALIANT?

Valiant is an Erasmus Key Action 3 Policy Experimentation Project that sets out to develop Virtual Exchange programmes called *Virtual Innovation and Support Networks*.

Virtual Exchanges aim to create a network where educational experts, teachers and student teachers can collaborate, exchange ideas, and have access to teaching resources.
